<p>In 2023, 87% of BorgWarner's revenue came from electric vehicles (EVs) and emissions-reducing hybrid and combustion products, such as turbochargers and exhaust gas recirculation valves and coolers. The other 13% of our revenue came from transfer cases and low-efficiency starters and alternators, which do not have a direct impact on fuel efficiency.</p>	<p>Emissions claims related to BorgWarner's emissions-reducing products are documented on page 14 and 34 of BorgWarner's 2025 Sustainability Report. These emissions claims are not verified by an independent third-party.</p>
<p>BorgWarner discloses avoided emissions and efficiency metrics for its battery packs, inverters, and turbochargers.</p>	<p>Emissions claims related to BorgWarner's EV and emissions-reducing products are documented on page 30 of BorgWarner's 2025 Sustainability Report. These emissions claims are not verified by an independent third-party.</p>
