Joseph F. Fadool has served as the President and Chief Executive Officer of the Company since February 2025. He was Executive Vice President and Chief Operating Officer of the Company from July 2024 to February 2025.

Prior to his current role, Fadool also held a number of top positions across the Company, including President and General Manager of Emissions, Thermal and Turbo Systems, Morse Systems and TorqTransfer Systems, the precursor to PowerDrive Systems.

Prior to joining BorgWarner in 2010, Fadool worked at Continental as Vice President for North American Electronic Operations. He previously held various positions with increasing responsibility at Continental and Siemens VDO Automotive including general management, operations, sales, and program management. Prior to joining Continental, Fadool spent seven years with Ford Motor Company, where he was involved in product development, and the launches of several major vehicles.

Fadool earned a Bachelor of Science in electrical engineering from Lawrence Technological University and received a Master of Science in computer and electronic controls from Wayne State University. He is a member of SAE.
